WELLNESS & WOOD: When natural design solutions contribute to wellness and wellbeing



During *3daysofdesign* 2024, the popular Ø chair, designed by Øivind Slaatto in 2020, will be launched as a swivel variant, bringing a renewed view on the traditional swivel chair. With its simple and unpretentious design, Ø Swivel brings lightness and elegance to any interior.

Functionality is ensured without compromising on design both at home and at the office. The \varnothing chair was born from the result of a design collaboration between \varnothing ivind Slaatto and Magnus Olesen A/S with a focus on 'Design for Disassembly'. The \varnothing chair was nominated for 'Green Product of the Year' at the Design Awards 2020. The expansion of the series now offers the possibility of furnishing different areas in the same style.


